FLORENT BERGAL (France) Director

Iorent Bergal was formed in the 'Center des Arts du cirque de Toulouse le Lido ', and was founder and director of the Company Les Bistaki. He participated in the Polo Circo with the show Les Oktubre. Among his other shows, Pop Corn Machine, por My-Laika, Cirkopolis by Cirqueon Prague, Cirk VOST ', Finding no man's land.

After his training in Le Lido Centre des Arts Du Cirque de Toulouse, he continues his training in Contemporary Dance that he traspasses to to his work in the Circus. As a dancer, he continued his works in dance company of Roberto Olivan and Nadi Brocante, and as a dance teacher in the Circus schools of Toulouse, Lille, Nîmes, Milan, Turin, Rotterdam and the Instutut de Teatro de Barcelona. Since 2008 he co-directs the Experimentation Center of El Lido.






